**The Young Adult (YA) Certified Nursing Assistant (CNA) Program**

**The YA program consists of three unique phases**

**Phase 1: GCD Career Readiness and Healthcare Professional Development (2 weeks)**

Prepares participants for the workforce with job readiness training. Participants also benefit from GCD's social services including case management & connection to necessary resources. Provides an introduction to health education and exposes participants to clinical skills, & professional development in a contextualized workplace setting. (Dates January 12<sup>th</sup> to January 22<sup>nd</sup>\*)

**Phase 2: CNA Online Training with local training Provider (8 weeks)**

During this phase, participants will work with several online platforms at the instruction of our New York State Certified Department of Health approved training provider to earn their CNA certification. Attendance, punctuality, & mastery of CNA skills are mandatory for completion and certification. (Dates January 25<sup>th</sup>- March 12<sup>th</sup>\*)

**Phase 3: Clinical Rotation and Temporary Hire as a CNA at The New Jewish Home and Connection to permanent employment (4 weeks)**

Those who successfully complete both phases of the program will begin onboarding to CNA roles at TNJH throughout the nursing department. Additionally, during this time, participants will explore furthering their education/certifications and partake in a graduation ceremony. It is important to note: our transitional services include, but are not limited to, Alumni events, career coaching, referrals & individual follow-up. (Dates March 16<sup>th</sup>- April 2<sup>nd</sup>\*)

- *Must be between 18-24 years old on **January 12, 2021***
